



Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce that we are now inviting nominations for the *Journal of Fungi* 2021 Young Investigator Awards. This prize will be given to three young investigators in recognition of her/his excellence in the field of pathogenic fungi, fungal biology, and all other aspects of fungal research. All nominations will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. David S. Perlin.

The prize:

- One 2000 CHF (Swiss Francs) for Primary Awardee; Two 1000 CHF (Swiss Francs) for Runner-up Awardees;
- The option to publish one paper free of charge in the *Journal of Fungi* after peer review, before the end of 2022;
- An engraved plaque.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Nominees must be below 40 years of age and must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2019;
- They must have produced ground-breaking research and a significant contribution to the advancement of pathogenic fungi, fungal biology, and all other aspects of fungal research;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- A detailed Curriculum Vitae including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- A birth certificate or other proof of age;
- A scanned copy of their doctorate certificate;
- A signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule

- Open for nominations: 1st March 2021.
- Nomination deadline: 31st October 2021.
- Winner announced: 31st December 2021.

- The nominations must be submitted online.
